DOCUMENTS REQUIRED

The following documents should be presented in order to support your visa application. All documents must be in English language.

- 1. 2 passport photos
- 2. Original passport + photocopy of passport
- 3. Employment letter in English language.
- 4. Confirmed Hotel Reservation: copy of a signed and stamped invoice stating paid and non-refundable or a letter from the hotel confirming amount paid and non-refundable.
- 5. If you are renting an apartment or Chalet you need to provide a written and signed proof from the property owner or realtor.
- 6. "Assumption of Responsibility for Hosting" form, if applicant will not reside at a hotel
- 7. Signed and stamped bank statement of last three (3) months with reasonable balance amount.
- 8. Under age children (below 18), that intend to enter Cyprus unaccompanied, should present a statement signed by both parents and stamped by the mayor of their area. If children are accompanied by one parent only, the authorization of the other parent is required.
- 9. Airplane ticket showing clearly the travel itinerary.

NOTE: If the current passport was renovated in less than 6 months, the previous passport is required to complete the application.

If applicant has a valid, double and/or multiple entries Schengen visa on his/her passport, he/she can enter Cyprus without a visa.

University students should present their University ID or a letter stating that they are enrolled to this Institution.

Domestic staff (housekeepers, nannies, drivers etc) that accompany their employer should present a valid residence and work permit to Jordan. Their employer should sign the "Sponsorship letter" form.

UN International staff, whose passport has been issued either in New York or Geneva, as well as UNIFIL staff possessing a UNIFIL Identity Card, may travel to Cyprus without a visa.

Iraqi nationals not holding valid residence permits in Jordan and wish to travel to Cyprus as tourists are required to provide:

- 1. Bank guarantee
- 2. Assumption of responsibility

Note: Applicants can apply for multiple-entry visa to Cyprus in the below cases:

- 1. If the applicant owns a house in Cyprus. For this case, the applicant can also apply for multiple-entry visa for his wife, children and parents.
- 2. If the business invitation requires multiple-entry visa for the applicant.
